2. Fishing shall be restricted to the Canadian waters of Lake Erie.
3. **Measuring of fish will take place adjacent to the Boat Launch at Wheatley Harbour. ENTRIES MUST BE IN THE MEASUREMENT LINEUP AT THE MEASUREMENT STATION TENT WITH FISH IN HAND WHEN HORN DEADLINE IS SOUNDED.**
4. The tournament shall be in effect Fri., July 27 until Sat., Aug. 4 from 5 a.m. - 7 p.m. and Sun., Aug 5 from 5 a.m. - 1 p.m.
5. Measuring will be 9 a.m. - 7 p.m. Fri., July 27 through Sat., Aug. 4; and until 1 p.m. Sun., Aug 5, 2018
6. **No measuring will be accepted after 7 p.m. on Fri., July 27 through Sat., Aug. 5 and 1 p.m. on Sun., Aug. 5, 2018.**
7. Only 1 grand prize may be won by an individual angler and that prize shall be their highest placing fish in each division.
8. **NO TIES** – longest fish shall remain in its place unless beaten by a longer fish.
9. Each person by signing an entry form and paying an entry fee acknowledges that he/she has read and understands the rules and regulations of this contest and undertakes to abide by all of the rules and regulations of the SWOC Tournament Committee and decision of tournament judges.
